

## Gold Coast Says 'Yes' to Daylight Saving in DS4SEQ Referendum

The Gold Coast has embraced a proposal to introduce Daylight Saving into South East Queensland, by voting in an unofficial referendum arranged by the Daylight Saving for South East Queensland Party.

"We were overwhelmed with the reaction of support we received from the Gold Coast locals," Daylight Saving for South East Queensland Party Leader, Jason Furze, said.

In just over two hours, more than 1,000 people took part in the survey. Almost 90 per cent of people who voted said they wanted Daylight Saving and 84 per cent supported a trial of Daylight Saving in South East Queensland only, followed by a state-wide Referendum.

"That's a resounding 'Yes' from the people of the Gold Coast," Mr Furze said.

Mr Furze said that this result reflects greater support than the Gold Coast vote in the 1992 Daylight Saving Referendum.

"In addition, just over 60 per cent of respondents said they were prepared to vote for the Daylight Saving for South East Queensland Party ahead of the other parties, in the next state election, should the Premier not proceed with a trial," Mr Furze said.

"It's clear that the people of the Gold Coast want Daylight Saving and we will be passing these poll results on to the Premier," Mr Furze said.
