'DAYLIGHT SAVING FOR SOUTH EAST QUEENSLAND' TO PROVIDE A VOICE FOR THE PEOPLE

On the issue of Daylight Saving, South East Queenslanders have been ignored for too long!

The people of South East Queensland have had no voice on this matter and no opportunity to illustrate that Daylight Saving Time IS an election issue.

That is, until now!

'Daylight Saving for South East Queensland', or 'DS4SEQ' for short, is to establish a 'single issue' Queensland political party. The application to register as a political party is about to be lodged with the Electoral Commission of Queensland and will be processed over the next few weeks.

The only objective of the Daylight Saving for South East Queensland Party will be to:

Introduce Daylight Saving Time into South East Queensland

Despite a clear majority of residents in South East Queensland supporting the introduction of Daylight Saving Time, the subject continues to be evaded by the major political parties.

DS4SEQ will participate in the next State election, on this sole policy, and allow the constituents of South East Queensland to have their say on this issue for the first time in over 16 years.

Since the 1992 Referendum on Daylight Saving, the number of residents on the Queensland electoral roll has increased from 1.8 million to 2.6 million. This means there are at least 800,000 voters who have NEVER had a say on the issue of daylight saving in Queensland – 700,000 of whom call South East Queensland home, and deserve the chance to be heard on this issue.

We encourage individuals who are registered on the Queensland electoral roll, and would like daylight saving time introduced into South East Queensland, to join DS4SEQ as a member – free of charge.
